



# Monroe Economic Development Commission Wins Aerospace Industry Award

11-6-08 The Monroe Economic Development Commission is one of five winners in Expansion Solutions Magazine's 2008 Awards for Excellence in the aerospace industry category. Intensifying its aerospace recruitment in 2002, the Monroe EDC has doubled the City's aerospace related firms and announced just under one-half billion dollars in new aerospace investment. Recent investments include \$260 by ATI Allvac, a leader in the production of titanium and nickel-base superalloys for Boeing and other clients. Just prior to this announcement in 2007, Turbomeca Manufacturing, a subsidiary of Safran Group, Inc. selected Monroe for a \$50 million facility to make aircraft engine parts. Earlier this year, Goodrich Corporation began a \$5.5 million investment to double its customer service headquarters and maintenance, repair and overhaul campus in Monroe.
